Recently we worked with County officials to extend the Bowleys Quarters Rd. sidewalk and are still involved in efforts to address the flood prone portion of Bowleys Quarters Rd.

A major focus of the BQIA is keeping members informed. Whether it be proposed development or happenings in and around the area, if we know about it, so will you. General Meetings at the BQIA Hall, the second Thursday of each month, provide a venue for developers, business and property owners, government officials and organizations to provide pertinent information for you to make informed decisions. Property owning members are eligible to vote on important issues affecting the community. These voting results are provided to government agencies requesting community input. Annual dues of \$25.00 per household and fun fund raisers held by the Association or by our Just BQuz group help to supplement BQIA hall costs, initiatives and charitable endeavors. Events include the annual Holiday Giving Celebration, Bull and Oyster Roast and Mother's Day Breakfast. Just BQuz events offered this year include Bowl Painting, Italian Dinner and Wine Tasting, trips and tours, craft and exercise/health seminars, and community safety and charitable projects such as the Waterwise Cardboard Boat Race and Coffee for Vets. We are fortunate to be one of the very few neighborhood organizations in the State to have its own hall and we enjoy using it for these events and more. (Members receive a reduced hall rental price).
