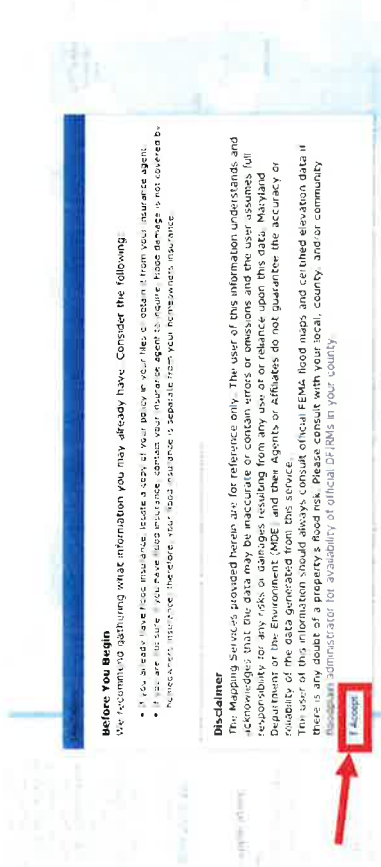


INSTRUCTIONS TO VIEW THE PRELIMINARY MAPS ONLINE

1. Go to www.mdffloodmaps.com
2. On the right side of the webpage, select "Flood Risk Application"



3. Read the disclaimer and select "I Accept"



4. Find your property by entering the address in the search bar in the top right corner of the tool. You can also zoom in and out using the scrolling wheel on your mouse or the zoom buttons in the top left corner of the tool.



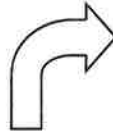
5. The 100-year floodplain (A or AE) is shown in purple. If you are in a detailed study area, the 500-year (non-regulatory) floodplain will be shown crosshatched, and the floodway will be shown as a blue, diagonally hatched area.



6. To better see your property relative to the floodplain, change the basemap using the drop down menu at the top of the tool.



“Imagery with labels” is recommended since you can see buildings and other structures



7. For additional information, select the “Determine Flood Status” button at the top of the toolbar and click a location on your parcel.

A screen will pop up with information on mapping, contacts, and more. Scroll through these screens using the blue arrow on the right side of the box. On the last screen you will be able to generate a summary report or print the map for your records.
